Newport Beaches

Easton's Beach (1st Beach)

Newport's largest beach and recreation area. It is the only area beach that has a carousel, aquarium, rentable beach houses and food concession area. Great for kids and families! At the end of the beach, a popular outdoor restaurant and patio bar (Atlantic Beach Club) offers guests drinks, food and live music on weekend afternoons. Parking fees range from \$10 on weekdays to \$15 on weekends/holidays and season passes are \$40 for residents / \$80 for nonresidents.

Bailey's Beach

This is a very small beach located at the intersection of Bellevue Avenue and Ocean Drive. Accessible only by foot or bike, it is a great place to stop on a bike ride and relax and watch the surf. The larger area of the beach past the rocks is private and part of the Spouting Rock Beach Association. FREE.

Gooseberry Beach

Located just beyond Bailey's Beach on Ocean Drive, Gooseberry is a great family beach because it lies in a protected area away from high surf. Fees are \$10 for parking or \$125 for season pass.

Fort Adams State Beach

Situated at the mouth of the Newport Harbor, Fort Adams State Park offers an exceptional panoramic view of both Newport Harbor and the East Passage of Narragansett Bay. The park offers a wide range of activities including salt water bathing, fishing, boating, soccer, rugby, and picnicking. Fort Adams is perhaps best known for its annual summer concerts when the Jazz Festival, and the Folk Festival draw thousands to enjoy the music and beautiful surroundings.
